

Recertification



A DMERT Certified Technician need only recertify at the highest level attain, i.e. DMERT Level 2 need only renew DMERT Level 2. DMERT Recertification is valid for 2 years from prior certification expiration date.

Requirements for DMERT Recertification at any level:

- **20 hours of documented CECs/CEUs** from approved rehab industry course(s) related to the provision of assistive technology to persons with disabilities. These must be documented as 10 hours completed per year in the 2 years prior to recertification and are to include: 20 Continuing Education Credits (CECs), 2.0 Continuing Education Units (CEUs) or a combination there of equaling 20 hours of education. Copy of attendance certificate(s) displaying the following items must be submitted to DMERT Group with completed Recertification form:
 - Candidate Name
 - Course Title
 - Instructor/Sponsor Signature
 - Course Date(s) and Length/Time
 - Number of CEUs awarded must be indicated, otherwise course will be recorded as contact hours (CECs)

CEUs will be accepted from IACET-accredited providers, professional associations, academic institutions, and state licensing boards. All submissions will be reviewed for qualification by the DMERT Group.
